## <u>Plot</u>

Scrooge left alone at school, at Christmas, as a child Scrooge working at Fezziwig's and the party where he has fun Scrooge being dumped by Belle because of greed

#### Language

Repetition of the word 'solitary' (loneliness)

Pronoun 'it' for the ghost = no gender = supernatural object

Repetition of the word 'melancholy' (sad/lonely)

Simile to describe the ghost's appearance (just like when introduced to Scrooge)

Adverbs to show emotion 'gaily' = happy

Irony – name of gf, frost on window,

Metaphor for the fog = his cloudy vision on life

Pathetic fallacy = weather reflects Scrooge (fog goes when go to his childhood)

## **Symbols**

Bell = Gf's name (Belle) = God & warning

## **Context**

Rich = ruins relationship with people

### **Structure**

Corruption of time = confusion = supernatural element

## **Setting**

Romantic setting to dump scrooge.

## **Character**

Scrooge - child, apprentice, dumped

Ghost of Christmas Past – Light = life & happiness

Fezziwig – boss & happy

Fan (sister – mother of Fred)

Belle – Girlfriend who dumps Scrooge

# **Theme**

Greed – girlfriend dumps him

Family – happiness when going home from school

Christmas – happiness at the party
