Plot

Ghost of Christmas Present – Festive colours, changes Scrooge's room.

Streets of London and the poor being happy whilst working

Cratchit family Christmas = family / happiness = respect everything

Lots of people in isolated places but they are happy (mine, prison, ship, lighthouse)

Fred's house = party / happiness with games and songs
Ignorance (boy) and Want (girl) – warning about the boy

Language

Dental alliteration & precious adjectives for Tiny Tim.

Happiness for the poor (especially Cratchit children

Personification of objects to show happiness (potatoes & pudding)

Adverb 'timidly' for Scrooge entering the room = scared.

Repetition of 'solitary' and 'Tiny'

<u>Symbols</u>

Fire = light & happiness

Singing = everyone is singing or humming = happiness

Context

Victorian England – streets = metaphorical snow = rich smothering the poor

- Poor people celebrating and being happy with what they get.

Queen Victoria – ideal Christmas with family and her portrait

Structure

We start with irregular time (he's gone back in time)

He lives Christmas day with the Ghost in a supernatural way

End the stave in real time (Next Ghost comes to Scrooge) & the
